An outing has been arranged to travel to Mallow and Listowel to see the *Mallow Level Crossing Control Centre (LCCC) & South Cabin* and visit the *Lartigue Monorail and Museum* on Saturday 16th March 2024. The outing will travel from Dublin to Mallow & Tralee by Iarnród Éireann service train and between Tralee & Listowel via private coach. A three-course lunch has been arranged for the group at the Listowel Arms Hotel and this is **included** in the ticket price.

Due to the limitations on the number of people that can be accommodated in the LCCC at a time, this outing is limited to a maximum of **40 people**. The visit to the LCCC and South Cabin will be conducted in small groups, lasting for 10 minutes at each location.
